General Tip:	

I have heard it said on a number of occasions lately, that giving your birds Baycox to treat for Coccidiosis will create flecking in your birds. I have spoken to our Hon Veterinarian re this and there is no reason why this medication would cause flecking.

If you had a clean cap bird, then it appeared flecked after a moult, then it will probable revert back to a clean cap the next moult and so on.

In our June magazine, I will have a full length article on flecking that was presented to our Judges Meeting last weekend in which there are over 40 birds displaying differing amounts of flecking and the degrees of penalty awarded against these birds. If we have enough time at our meeting next week, Keith Gough may be able to show you the photos on the big screen.
