Wet weather can bring heartache and joy to an aviary. The heartache is the spread of Coccidiosis in the aviary. This dreaded disease can wipe out an entire flock within days, but treatment is very successful. Baycox is generally used or a Sulpha Drug. Please see AJ or Ron Woodhead on Thursday evening and obtain some. These products are a must in every aviary medicine cabinet.

The joy of wet weather is that the birds know there is water around and it helps them come into breeding condition. So, if your birds are ready, put them down and watch the fertility come (fingers crossed).

Cross contamination is of a major concern if you have any illness or problem in your aviary. Breeders check the nest boxes, check eggs for fertility, number the eggs and then go straight onto the next box and do the same. If you have a problem evolving in the first box, you can very easily transfer it to the entire aviary. It is wise to have hand sanitiser or wipes handy and clean your hands between each nest.

Club Magazine will be issued at our meeting so that is another reason to attend. I know a number of you do not like the emailed form of it, so there is a simple solution. Attend our meeting next week and receive a hard copy.
