Now is the time to catch out any 2022 rung young bird that you bred yourself and look at them, carefully. Have they got broken tail? If so, pull it out so a new one will be fully grown for the Zone Selection. Check for Scaley mite, red mite etc. Some birds are prone to these problems. We used to have a family of Clearwings that always got Scaley so treatment for them was twice as often as the other birds. We now have a family of Recessive Pied, that will have to be treated for mite more often. These are little things you should be picking up.

You think that because you are a Novice your birds won't be good enough? That is not true. There have been Novice birds go to the Zones before. Let the judges decide on their quality. The main thing is that you are representing your club.
